- **Demographic Focus:** Organizations serving girls aged 14-25 from underserved communities in Metro Atlanta and across North Georgia .
- **Community Reach:** A demonstrated ability to engage directly with the intended population in meaningful and sustainable ways.

Capacity and Resources

- **Program Infrastructure:** Ability to support and sustain programming in collaboration with our organization.
- **Qualified Staff/Volunteers:** Staff or volunteers with experience working with youth, especially from diverse and disadvantaged backgrounds.
- **Facility Access:** Availability of safe and accessible spaces for program delivery, if applicable.

- **Collaborative Spirit:** Willingness to actively collaborate, share resources, and work towards shared goals.

- **Communication and Feedback:** Commitment to regular communication and participation in joint evaluation and reporting efforts.
- **Sustainability Focus:** Interest in developing long-term relationships and creating sustainable impact.

Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion

- **Cultural Sensitivity:** Programs that recognize and respect the diverse cultural backgrounds, experiences and needs of the young women and girls we serve.
- **Inclusivity Practices:** Commitment to fostering an inclusive environment where all participants feel valued and supported.

Accountability and Transparency

- **Impact Measurement:** Ability to track, measure, and report on program outcomes and effectiveness.
- **Financial Responsibility:** Evidence of transparent and sound financial management practices, and adherence to any financial reporting requirements, where funding or grant agreements are part of the collaboration.

Legal and Ethical Compliance

- **Compliance Standards:** Adherence to legal and ethical standards, including child protection policies.
- **Non-Discrimination:** Policies that prohibit discrimination based on race, ethnicity, religion, socioeconomic status, disability status, gender identity, sexual orientation, or any other protected class.
